

Housing Options for ALP Students
American Language Program, Ohio State University
Autumn Quarter 2009

There are several options for permanent housing for ALP students:

1. **University dormitories:** ALP students can live in University dormitories, but it is important to apply in advance because the dormitories fill up quickly. You can learn about the dormitories on the OSU Housing Office web site: <http://www.housing.osu.edu>. If you want an application for University dormitories sent to you, call or e-mail ALP immediately:

If there is still space available in the dormitories, you can make arrangements after you arrive. Please remember that we cannot guarantee a dormitory room for you.

2. **Off-campus apartments:** You should plan to arrive in Columbus one or two weeks in advance of the program. Apartments near campus often fill up quickly, so the earlier you begin your search, the more housing options you will have. In addition, a housing coordinator in the Office of Off-Campus Housing (<http://www.osuoffcampus.com>) can assist you. Prices range from an absolute minimum of \$150 per month in rooming houses to a more realistic \$300 - \$500 per month, if you share an apartment. Students living either on- or off-campus may eat in Ohio State's food service facilities with payment.

3. **Private dormitories:** The following private dormitories are furnished and are located directly across the street from the university:
